Introduction

Theory and History of Ontology, created April 13, 2000, moved August 13, 2010 from www.formalontology.it to a new address: www.ontology.co

The site is available in two different location (the content is identical): at a European address (www.ontology.co) and at an address in the United States (www.ontology-2.com); a mobile version is also available (m.ontology.co)

The site contains: 291 web pages (166 contains the Bibliographies), 13 essays in PDF format, and more than 13.000 bibliographic references; it is best viewed with a recent version of one of the following browsers: Firefox, Internet Explorer, Chrome, Opera, Safari.

I am currently adding to the existing Bibliographies abstracts or quotations that will, I think, facilitate study for the truly interested readers.

There are also two sites (currently under development) for, respectively, Italian (www.ontologia.co) and French (www.ontologie.co) readers, that will contain bibliographical information and references to works published in the cited languages.

Note on the Fonts

The fonts used are:

- For the text: Georgia (Windows, Macintosh, Linux);
- For the logical symbols: Lucida Sans Unicode (Windows); Lucida Grande (Macintosh); Lucida Sans or DejaVu Sans Condensed (Linux);

- For the citations in Ancient Greek: New Athena Unicode (Windows, Macintosh, Linux; embedded as Web Font in "Web Open Fonts Format" = WOFF);

Web Open Fonts are compatible with the following browsers:

- Camino (only for Macintosh) 2.1
- Chrome: version 5.0
- Internet Explorer: version 9
- Firefox: version: 3.6
- Opera: version 11.10
- Safari: version 5.1
- SeaMonkey 2.1

Readers with browsers that does not support WOFF or who cannot see the Greek characters correctly can download the freeware font New Athena Unicode by the American Philological Association, otherwise they will see the Greek with the font Palatino Linotype.

Note for the Webmasters

For the best performance, from June 15, 2011 the main site www.ontology.co (hosted on a European server) is mirrored on an American Server at the address www.ontology-2.com but if you want to link a page of my site please use the address www.ontology.co for the pages in HTML format because the mirror site will not be indexed by the Search Engines (to avoid duplicated content).

The files in PDF format will be available only on the mirror site at the address www.ontology-2.com/pdf (essays by other Authors and the PDF version of the HTML pages).
